

**Engensa Celebrates Energy Savings Week with First Solar Group Purchase Campaign

- Groups of 50 to 75 customers – Engensa will give each group member a free upgrade to our top of the line SolarEdge micro inverter (valued at £1500). This converts the energy produced by solar panels into electricity for homes and to feed into the national grid. The SolarEdge micro inverter comes with a monitoring system.
