Energy firm Engensa believes its newly launched free solar electricity scheme SunRoof could help families shave £300 off annual energy bills.

The company essentially 'rents' a roof - installing, monitoring and maintaining solar installations at no cost to the owner and providing free energy for the house.

Engensa makes its cash by selling any excess energy produced back to the Government as part of its feed-in tariff.

CEO Toby Darbyshire said:

"Solar is obviously a brilliant investment for families across the UK but we wanted to extend the benefits to those who don't have the money to invest but still want to benefit from dramatic cuts in their electricity bills and gain the satisfaction of turning their home green."
